- « The 2016-17 preliminary budget in the amount of \$7,945,207 which includes the use of \$129,680 from the fund balance was approved.
- « The 2016-17 IU9 Special Education Contract was approved at an estimated cost of \$610,339.
- « The 2016-17 Seneca Highlands CTC Budget in the amount of \$2,043,842 was approved.
- « A ten cent increase in school lunch prices for 2016-17 was approved bringing the cost of an ES lunch to \$1.85 and the MSHS lunch to \$1.95 for next year.
- « The tentative list of 2016 graduates, pending successful completion of all necessary requirements was approved.
- « The IU9's request to use one classroom from July 6 through July 28, 2016 for extended school year was approved.
- « The 2016-17 school calendar was approved.
- « Changes to the 2016-17 High School Course Directory were approved.
- « The School Based Intensive Case Manager 2016 Summer Program was approved.
- « Oswayo Valley was approved to host the 2017 IU9 Chorus Fest on April 20, 2017.
- « The Oswayo Valley Trap Club was approved as an activity of the Oswayo Valley School District .
- « TREMCO was approved to restore parts of the High School roof at a cost not to exceed \$337,454.63, pending receipt of 2015-16 funds.
