- « Report was given by Dr. Hartzell on PVAAS
- « Mr. Craig Moshier reported on a water quality assessment of the Oswayo River that was compiled and written by the students in his Environmental Science class.
- « The October 12, 2015 board meeting minutes were approved.
- « A change to the junior high wrestling schedule was approved. As a result of the tournament at Cameron County being canceled, OV wrestlers will now attend a tournament in Clarion on December 12.
- « Several field trips were approved for both Elementary and Middle/High School.
- « A resolution accepting the note purchaser proposal and authorizing issuance of a Tax Revenue Anticipation Note was approved. The funds will be used in the absence of a state approved budget.
- « A resolution was approved allowing for a transfer of funds from the general fund to the capital reserve fund for capital improvements.
- « An Act 1 resolution was approved to not raise the taxes above the State adjusted CPI for 2016—3.5%
- « A request from the Tax Claim Bureau of Potter County to remove Parcel Number 240-006-008-L1 from the assessment roll was approved.
- « Tim Ford, Danielle Gietler, and Mandy Smith were recognized for their contributions to the Board of Directors and for their continued support to the District. They completed their terms on the School Board.
