Transportation

Hand sanitizer will be available at the pickup and drop off for both runs on each bus. Students will be required to wear masks while on the bus. Buses will load from back to front with the first student going to the back of the bus with assigned seating based on pick up and drop off times on the roster. Parents are requested to follow the attached pre-screening guidelines prior to pick and students will be screened prior to entering the school. All students will not be permitted into the building until 7:55 due to staff's reporting time and screening procedures.

Elementary Transportation Plan

Elementary School drop off plan AM

Students in grades 3,4,5 will be dropped off at the double doors closest to the baseball/ softball fields if they are not eating breakfast

ANY student that is eating breakfast will be dropped off behind the school by the Library entrance.

Students in grades Pre-K, K,1, and 2 will be dropped off at the far end of the building by the basketball courts if they are not eating breakfast.

Student who are eating breakfast will be dropped off at the entrance in the back of the building. They will enter the building after being screened, grab a breakfast bag and proceed to their homeroom.

Afternoon Pick Up Procedures

Students in grades 3,4,5 will be dismissed and picked up through the double doors closest to the baseball/ softball fields. These students will be dismissed at staggered times.

Students in grades Pre-K, K,1, and 2 will be dismissed and picked up at the far end of the building by the basketball courts if they are not eating breakfast. These students will be dismissed at staggered times.

Parent pick up – PM Grades 3,4,5

Parents with children in grades 3,4, and 5 will use the main bus loop at the front of the building. If you have students in grades Pre-K, K,1,2 and 3,4, or 5, please use the drop off loop at the side of the building by the music room. Your child in grades 3,4, or 5 will walk around the building utilizing the sidewalk to the music room entrance.

Parent pick up – PM Grades Pre-K, K,1,2 – Only – Starting Monday September 28, 2020

Parents with children in grades Pre-K, K,1, or 2 only, will use the side entrance located to the far end of the building by the basketball courts/ apple orchard. Please use the large loop around the building, as the large circle is one way only.

High School Transportation Plan

Starting November 16, 2020

The back-parking lot is now closed due to surface and weather conditions. It will not be used.

The loop in the front of the school (parallel to the sidewalk) will be used for *buses and school vans* only—for both morning drop-off, to include breakfast and afternoon pick-up.

Passenger car morning drop-offs and afternoon pick-ups will enter the main parking lot, using one-way traffic to circle the lot and then park in the lined spaces perpendicular to the sidewalk for unloading and loading. Use the middle rows of parking for overflow. Cars must not park in the flow of traffic; cars must not parallel park to sidewalks. Breakfast students will also be dropped off in the main parking lot.

The afternoon CTC bus will park in the main parking lot, parallel to the main office and sidewalk.

Sports transportation will be dependent on PIAA guidelines.

Disinfecting of the Buses – Am Fogging and Clorox wiping of rails

PM – Fogging and Clorox wipe disinfecting

CTC students will be transported on one bus then driver will transfer to a disinfected bus for the regular bus run.

Masks are required on the bus

Drivers will not be able to take temperatures while loading the bus due to safety precautions please prescreen your children before leaving the home.

Sanitization Planning for Buildings

Daily electrostatic sanitizer will be used in all common areas and classrooms at the end of each school day.

High touch surfaces will be wiped between student group usage. (cafeteria, bathrooms, office spaces, recess facilities and equipment, touch surfaces in hallways)

Any time students change learning areas, desk wipe downs will occur. Each morning sanitization supplies will be provided for teachers to maintain each classroom.

Hand sanitizer will be used each time a person changes where they are working or learning.

Electrostatic Sanitization will occur in each school transportation vehicle between AM and PM runs.

All normal cleaning procedures will continue throughout the school year.

Cafeteria Plan

Elementary:

Breakfast will be provided as grab and go at each designated entrance for each building and students will report to their classrooms for breakfast. Elementary (Library Side Entrance, HS cafeteria entrance) for bused students and drop off students.

Lunch will be divided by classrooms K-2 will eat in the cafeteria, grades 3-5 will be delivered and to their classrooms.

Trash cans will be provided for students in grades 3-5 in the hallway to dispose of lunch trays.

Social distancing will be maintained in the cafeteria throughout the different lunch periods and in classrooms to the best of our ability.

MS/HS:

The middle/high school has added an additional lunch period to accommodate all students according to social distancing guidelines.

When students arrive at the cafeteria they will be cued about distancing while in the lunch line. Once students have their lunch they will report to their assigned space at the appropriate table. Signage will remind students that no trading or sharing of food is permitted.

Students will dispose of their trash by approaching garbage receptacles from one side and returning to their seats from the appropriate side.

Dismissal from the cafeteria will be by table; allowing for adequate space between students in the hallway.

Lunch Pick up will be available for Oswayo Valley's Distance Learning Students (Pre-K – 12) at the high school cafeteria entrance from 10:30 – 11:00am these are no longer free lunches unless students qualify for free or reduced lunch pricing.

Athletics Plan

Currently pending PIAA decision based on Governor Wolf's strong recommendation. We are waiting for more guidance to come from the PIAA.

Other Information

Restroom Use:

Elementary will be used the way they currently are as classrooms will take regular restroom breaks with sanitization being done hourly.

Secondary Restrooms will be used as needed and sanitized hourly.

Break Times:

Students will be given outdoor break times throughout the school day to give them social distancing times when masks will not be required.

Sharing of Classroom Materials:

Classroom materials will be divided and only used by one student to the best of our ability.

Technology will all be used 1:1 with each student being assigned a device.

Library:

1 Grade Level per day will be able to use the Elementary Library within our 6-day rotation.

Secondary Library will be able to be checked out and put on a table for students to pick up outside the Library.
