Dear Oswayo Valley School District Community:

This letter is to inform you of the current status of Oswayo Valley School District, regarding COVID-19 cases.

The district has been notified that a staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. The district will remain open for some students but not all due to the contact tracing by the CDC. Students who are notified due to contact tracing will remain in virtual instruction starting Monday, **November 16, 2020 through November 20, 2020**.

The district has coordinated efforts with the Pennsylvania Department of Health and has conducted contact tracing. Anyone who has been in contact with these individuals will be notified directly via the CDC and our One Call system. The Department of Health defines contact as anyone who has been within 6 feet or less for 15 minutes or more.

The primary symptoms of COVID-19 include shortness of breath, coughing, and fever or chills. Other symptoms include congestion, sore throat, diarrhea, abdominal pain, body aches, and loss of taste or smell. Anyone who needs medical care should call their healthcare provider to report an illness or exposure to COVID-19 prior to seeking care. We ask that you notify the school office if your student is tested for or tests positive for COVID-19.

We thank you for your continued support as we look to provide for the educational needs of our students. As always, our top priority is the health, safety, and well-being of our school community. We will continue to monitor the situation and provide updates as necessary to the school community. If you have any questions, please contact the main office.
