Dear OV Families,

The Oswayo Valley School District has multiple confirmed cases of Covid-19 within the Middle/High School. As a result, the District will be virtually instructing all students in grades PK-12 on February 23, 2021 for sanitization purposes. Students in grades Pre-K through 7 will return to in person instruction on February 24, 2021. Students in grades 8-12 will remain in virtual instruction through February 26, 2021.

Instruction:

- All students in grades 8-12 will be virtual from Tuesday, February 23 through Friday, February 26, 2021.
- Students in grades Pre-K -7th will be virtual on Tuesday, February 23 and return to full in person instruction on Wednesday, February 24, 2021.
- Staff members will be instructing from the school or from home depending on the contact tracing.
- CTC students will be instructed virtually throughout the entire time frame.

Athletics/Activities:

- All athletic events (practice & games) are canceled from February 22, 2021 through February 26, 2021.
- The National Honor Society Ceremony scheduled for February 25, 2021 has been postponed.
- Elementary tutoring is canceled for Tuesday, February 23, 2021, but will resume on Wednesday and Thursday as scheduled.

Food Service:

- Meals will be sent home Monday, February 22, 2021.

Transportation:

- Transportation will be available for students in grades Pre-K – 7 Wednesday through Friday.

Student Health

- Please call the school and notify the school nurse of any cases and/or Covid-19 symptoms for remote learners so we can make a valid decision whether we have too many cases to return to school.

Technology Replacement

- We have had multiple students lose computer parts throughout our virtual instruction, for example chargers for their Chromebook. Please be advised that parents will be charged if a student loses their charger or for any technology that is lost or broken. The projected cost for a charger is \$40, the cost for the lost or broken item will be on a case-by-case basis moving forward. Equipment will be held until the purchase is made by the parent or student.
