a. Universal and correct wearing of masks ;	Masks will be worn while students are on the bus then masks will not be required for students if they can maintain social distancing indoors or outdoors.

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b. Modifying facilities to allow for physical distancing (e.g., use of cohorts/podding);	Spacing of seating will be kept at the PA DOH's recommendations at the time of instruction.
c. Handwashing and respiratory etiquette ;	All supplies will be used as previously planned to keep students sanitized.
d. Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation ;	Daily backpack sprayer will be used to sanitize all facilities and used as needed based on contact tracing and confirmed cases within the building.
e. Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine , in collaboration with the State and local health departments;	Contact Tracing, isolation, and quarantine decisions will be made to align with the PA DOH's guidance.
f. Diagnostic and screening testing;	Daily screening will be done by parents at home for students, and testing will take place for students showing symptoms, pending parent consent.
g. Efforts to provide vaccinations to school communities ;	We've held two rounds of vaccinations at the school district and will provide two more options prior to the start of school.
h. Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies; and	All accommodations will be made for students with disabilities to be in compliance with IDEA.
i. Coordination with state and local health officials.	Notification will be given to the PA DOH as it was done in the previous plan.
