



As part of the State of Pennsylvania Act 44 initiative, the *Safe2Say Something* program was designed to facilitate the reporting of sensitive messages to school officials, including information regarding safety of all students, drugs/alcohol use, suicide, weapons, and/or students who may be in need of assistance. If an individual has concerns that a person may harm themselves or another person, they are encouraged to report this information to a trusted adult immediately, call 911, or contact the National Suicide Hotline at 1-800-273-8255. Please relay as much information as possible to include the name of the school(s) and person(s) involved, as well as what type of activities that are alleged and when the activities may occur or have occurred. **All emergencies should be directed to 911.**

Examples of tip line submissions may include but are not limited to:

- Abuse
- Alcohol and/or Drugs
- Bullying, harassment or intimidation
- Student self-harm concern
- Suicide (Suicide Prevention Hotline – 1-800-273-8255)
- Vandalism/Theft
- Weapon Concern

Any of the above actions are not conducive to a positive learning environment and are considered violations of the Oswayo Valley School District policy.

Safe2Say tips will be forwarded confidentially to appropriate school staff and/or local and state law enforcement. All local school district policy and procedures will be followed. **Please be advised that misuse of this feature or purposely submitting false claims may result in disciplinary action by school officials, the Office of the Attorney General, and Local and State Law Enforcement.**
