Oswayo Valley School District has updated their continuation of education plan and staff expectations.

This order takes effect at 8 p.m., Monday, March 30, 2020, and will continue until April 30, 2020. All stay-at-home orders are now extended through April 30, 2020. All Pennsylvania schools will remain closed until further notice. Non-life-sustaining business closures remain in effect.

Essential Staff:

All support staff contracted employees will be working throughout the school closure as essential employees. Please see the attached schedule in your email.

Education Plan:

- Oswayo Valley will continue Enrichment and Review activities throughout the end of the school year ending May 29, 2020. Please refer to the continuation of education plan posted to our district website.

- Parents will be able to make a call in to each teacher's voicemail and leave questions for the teachers to answer, as well as send emails to teachers to address questions or concerns.

Board Meeting

- We will be holding a Google meeting for our upcoming, budget work session, board work session, and voting meeting on April 6, 2020, beginning at 6:00 p.m.
- Mrs. Yohe, Mr. Hamberger, and 7 members will be able to attend the meeting and additional members will attend through a Google Meeting.

Athletic Update

- Community athletic organizations will not be granted access to the facilities during the duration of the mandated school closure for practice or games until school is reopened.
- Oswayo Valley School District has closed all spring athletic activities while the school closure is in effect.
- Building Use Requests will be denied until further notice.

Food Service Update

- We served 2,184 lunches on Monday to 273 students.
- We shifted to serving 8 meals for Monday through Thursday and 6 meals Friday through Sunday.
- Food Service Staff have returned to work and Administrators, Teachers, and Support Staff have volunteered to prep and serve lunches throughout the entire school closure.
- We have put in food orders and will be receiving full reimbursement for all lunches and breakfast served.

Educational Planning

- Summer prep work for teachers will begin on April 6, 2020, but have until April 10, 2020 to complete the end of the year check out process.
- As of March 31, 2020, we will continue to provide Enrichment and Review at this point up until May 29, 2020.
- Aides will be receiving a schedule to come into each building to assist the other support staff with their current responsibilities starting Monday, April 6, 2020.
- Monday, April 6, 2020 will be the day all elementary staff reports to the Elementary School to assist in the typical end of year building closure procedures.
- Tuesday, April 7, 2020 will be the day all secondary staff reports to the Middle/High School to assist in typical end of year building closure procedures.
- Wednesday, April 8, 2020, we will hold a parent pick up of student items to the attached schedule.
 - Elementary will pick up in the Pre-K drop off circle by the elementary gymnasium.
 - Middle/High School will pick up in the cafeteria loop.
